Terms and Procedures of the Ida Mae Wright Scholarship Program at Central Delaware Christian Academy.

The Ida Mae Wright Scholarship Program is made possible through the generous bequest of the late Ida Mae Wright as part of her effort to further education in Kent County, Delaware.

According to Ms. Wright's desires, the scholarship is to be given based on monetary need, academic achievement, and residence in Kent County, Delaware.

The following terms should be understood by parents applying for the Scholarship.

1. Scholarships are derived from the interest on principle given by Ms. Wright. Therefore, each year the amount available may vary based on investment rates, etc.
2. The scholarship must be applied for each year. There is no guarantee scholarships will be awarded to the same students for the same amount from year to year, although the Scholarship Committee will try to help students stay at CDCA.
3. Scholarship money is applied to student accounts on a monthly basis, and it is the parents or guardian's responsibility to keep their portion of tuition paid in a timely manner. If the parent's payments get more than two months behind, the scholarship will become void until the account is in good standing.
4. In the event there is a major change in a family's net income, the administrator should be notified within 30 days.
5. As with all programs at CDCA, the scholarship program is a privilege and not a right, and is in place to help as many families afford tuition as possible.
6. There will be no discrimination on awarding of scholarships based on race, gender or national origin.
7. Continued misbehavior or gross misconduct by the student can void scholarship money based on the administrations recommendations.
8. It is the intent of the Board of Directors that scholarship moneys will assist families at CDCA, and will usually be awarded in amounts of 10%, 25%, or 50% of tuition. In most cases, each family will be responsible for Registration, Book and Building Fund Fees.
9. All decisions of the Scholarship Committee in regards to students and amounts of awarded scholarships will be final.
10. The completed Application Form and other information listed on it will be required for consideration.
